The Drinking Water Bureau of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED-DWB) has received and reviewed your NELAP certification /accreditation information from the state of California. The documentation is acceptable and your New Mexico certification is now valid through June 30, 2011.

This certification is to perform drinking water analysis in compliance with the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act, pursuant to 40CFR Part 141, and the New Mexico Environment Department Drinking Water Regulations for the Primary Regulated contaminants, including contaminants as listed in your California Scope Accreditation.

You must advise NMED-DWB of any change in your accreditation by the State of California and continue to provide this office with performance evaluation results. Laboratories certified by New Mexico can be purged from the list if there is no evidence that they are performing drinking water compliance sample analysis for public water supply systems in New Mexico. The DWB lab certification program is being revised based on the 2010 EPA audit of the program. The new program guidance will be available May 2011, and all lab certifications will be reassessed after the guidance is issued.
